- 1. Applicant must be a member in good standing of LRBA, Inc. for at least two (2) years immediately prior to applying and be a legal resident of the State of Louisiana.
- 2. Applicant must have been actively engaged in breeding, raising and showing rabbits for at least two (2) years prior to applying.
- 3. Beginning with applications due by 12/31/2003, applicants must qualify for the

LRBA, Inc. sweepstakes contest for two (2) years immediately prior to applying.

4. Applicant may have graduated or be near graduation from high school, have a GED or be attending a post-secondary educational facility.

In the event that the mandatory shows are voted out at the state meeting, we would like for you to consider changing #3 to the following

3. Beginning with applications due by 12/31/2013, applicants must attend and participate in, both the Youth Scholarship show and the Annual State Show, for two (2) years immediately prior to applying, or have a Youth Advisory Board approved excuse. (Due to change in participation rules, accepted participation for years prior to 2013 will be for the youth to have one or more rabbits shown at the qualifying shows, with or without his/her attendance at the shows)

This would insure that the applicant was involved in LRBA activities prior to applying for the scholarship.

Rabbit digestive systems are capable of digesting greens, but they must develop the proper flora in their GI tract and that does not happen overnight so give tiny amounts of fresh edible stuff and build up. Monitor droppings and you will know if they are getting too much.

Just for fun: Brenda's homemade bunny biscuits by Brenda Plaxton – these are for TREATS – you can sub the carrots for pears or apples or???

- · small carrot, pureed
- 1/2 banana, mashed until really creamy
- · 1 tbsp honey
- 1/4 cup rabbit pellets, ground finely in a coffee grinder
- 1/4 cup ground oats, ground finely in a coffee grinder

Mix pureed carrot, banana and honey in a medium bowl. Add pellet powder and ground oats. Mix until blended. Knead in your hands for 1-2 minutes. Roll out the "dough" in 1/8- to 1/4-inch thick layers between sheets of plastic wrap. Cut into small cookies (about 3/4 inch across). Place cut shapes onto a parchment paper covered cookie sheet. Bake at 325 degrees for about 30 minutes (check to make sure they are not browning too much). Turn off the heat and let the cookies sit in the warm oven for an hour or so.


