LRBA, Inc. Annual State Meeting 6/26/10

The Annual State Meeting of the Louisiana Rabbit Breeders Assoc., Inc. was called to order at 8:28 AM on June 26, 2010 in Raceland, LA with President Lynn Hebert presiding.

Roll call was taken by means of a sign-in sheet with 29 adult members and 24 youth members present.

Gwen Himel moved to accept the minutes as read by Kevin LeBlanc, LRBA Secretary; Seconded by Lance Gendron, motion passed. Kevin LeBlanc, LRBA Secretary presented the Report of the Secretary. Membership: 233 overall members, 145 adult and 88 youth.

There are 8 clubs affiliated with LRBA at this time, Central Louisiana, Magnolia State, South Mississippi, South Louisiana, Bonne Terre, Acadiana, Tri-Parish Dutch and Louisiana Mini Rex.

Glenn Waters moved to accept the Report of the Treasurer as presented by Lori Neagle; seconded by Lance Gendron, motion passed.

Lance Gendron moved to accept the Executive Board Report as presented by Lori Neagle; seconded by Gwen Himel, motion passed.

Reports of committees: Trailer Acquisition Committee (Lynn Hebert, Lance Gendron and Kevin LeBlanc) reported that a trailer was purchased under budget and the Audit Committee (Amy Lukaszeski and Tyrone Freeman) reported that balances were ok. Youth Advisory Committee (No Report)

Wallace Fontenot to handle concessions. Awards, trophies for breeds with 15+ rabbits exhibited and rosettes for anything under. To check into medallions for youth. Specialties suggested for the show were Mini Rex, Holland Lop, Dutch and Netherland Dwarf. It was suggested to have 6 judges and 1 backup judge.

Other Business: Lori Neagle moved to up late registration fees at LRBA sponsored events to \$4.00. Seconded by Ariana St. Pierre, motion passed.
