From the desk of the LRBA President

Hello fellow rabbit hobby enthusiasts. This LRBA rabbit show season is one for the record books. We have had many more entries this vear than we have had in recent vears. I continue to see more and more exhibitors joining our hobby. We have had more all breed shows sanctioned by the LRBA this year than any year since I began showing rabbits and we still have several shows to look forward to. Most of the local clubs have already held their annual rabbit shows, but we still have the Iowa Rabbit Festival coming up on March 19th as well as two shows to be put on by LRBA, Inc.

I want to take this opportunity to encourage you to exhibit your rabbits at the upcoming shows to be put on by LRBA, Inc. On April 2nd LRBA will be putting on a show at Southern University. Southern University does pay premiums to the winners in the youth show and also pays some nice prices for the winners in the meat pen class.

On Memorial Day weekend, the LRBA, Inc. will be hosting a big triple show in Church Point. Lori Neagle has been hard at work on this project. She has hired 5 judges from out of state. This project went off really nicely the last two years and this year it should be even better. We will have an indoor facility with air conditioning. We have two judges coming in to judge from California as well as two from Ohio and one from Texas. This should be a really nice event.

I want to take this opportunity to make a point. All LRBA sanctioned rabbit shows are held in accordance with ARBA rules. One ARBA rule states that at all youth rabbit shows the rabbits are to be put on the table by a youth. At a recent show one of the parents asked me about this. When I looked at the show table, there were so many adults putting rabbits on the table that I thought it was the open show. People please follow this rule and have only youth putting rabbits on the table to be

judged in the youth shows, it is not just a good idea, it is an ARBA rule.

I know that at this time the LRBA annual meeting seems a long way off, but it is time for anyone wanting to propose a change to the Constitution & By-Laws to get their proposal in written form. Remember that any proposed change must be submitted to the Secretary 45 days prior to the Annual State Meeting. The exact date of the annual meeting as well as it's location is still being discussed at this time, so be sure to read the May newsletter for that information.

As you read this article, may all of you have nest boxes full of potential winners. Good luck and may God bless.



He worked thirty-two years at Cities Service, retiring as a supervisor. Ethel was a homemaker and especially skilled at cooking and gardening The family enjoyed breeding and raising rabbits. Guy was an ARBA judge for over forty vears. He was the first inductee into the LRBA Hall of Fame and received the ARBA Distinguished Service Award.

Guy & Ethel devoted their lives to family, children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. They will be missed.

LRBA member and ARBA Judge Bobby Walker of Boles, AR passed away on January 11, 2011. Bobby and family started breeding and showing rabbits in 1976 with French Lops and Rex. As far as history on the piece, it was acquired from Mrs. D.C. Jones. The organ was brought from the northeast United States and belonged to her in-laws. At the time the Vincent family acquired it from Mrs. Jones around the year 2000, Mrs. Jones believed it was approximately 100 years old. It still plays somewhat, unfortunately, the leather baffles are worn out and need to be changed. It is approximately 5 feet by 2 feet.

The organ will need to be picked up from our home located in Coteau, LA which is approximately 20 minutes south of Lafayette, LA within one (1) month of the end of auction. If it is not picked up within 1 month, the next bidder will be awarded the organ.

The winner will be announced at the LRBA State Show on March 12, 2001.

Remember this is a donation to benefit the youth of your state. All donations are deeply appreciated.
