MEDICAL TIPS

Christy Elster, DVM, of Kees Park Animal Hospital in Pineville, La. is one of the most rabbit savvy vets around! She has saved several rabbits from our barn, removed a tumor from our guinea pig, tended numerous cats and can solve almost any critter mystery.

Dr. Elster gave me permission to share a recipe with LRBA newsletter readers that I believe has saved several of Alyssa's

rabbits over the last few years. This is a homemade version of products such as Critical Care from Oxbow Animal Health. Make sure that fresh water and pelleted feed are available to your rabbit as they recover.

1 cup rabbit pellets

8 ounces Ensure Complete (or nutrition shake with fiber)

8 ounces Yoplait yogurt with fiber (or yogurt with fiber)

Mix all ingredients together using a blender, hand mixer or whisk. You may need to let the pellets soak longer to make it easier to mix. Add water if needed. The mixture should be the consistency of cookie batter. Refrigerate. Feed two tablespoons to half a cup of mixture in a bowl once or twice a day. If the animal is severely debilitated or refuses to eat, thin mixture with water and feed using a syringe every 3 hours or so. Rabbits usually start eating the mixture out of a bowl in a few days.

Wean your rabbit off the pellet mixture as they begin to feel better and return to eating their regular diet. – Tammy Lloid


